For 18 countries, students have to take health examination at designated hospitals. Please consult the Korean embassy or Consulate office for further details.																		
Health Insurance	Exchange students or their parents/guardians are responsible for the cost of treatment should any medical emergencies arise. Students should bring comprehensive travel and medical insurance before coming to Korea and verify that the insurance policy they carry covers hospitalization and medical care occurring during international travel and sojourns, as well as repatriation to their home country in case of medical emergency.
